

Teacher and Support Staff Assignments for **Yellow Plan 2020**

Originally, our yellow plan was written to reflect a reduction in the number of students in the building by half. In the weeks since it was approved by the board, the other schools in SU 93 have developed yellow plans that consider low classroom numbers, students in special services and the youngest learners. With board approval, I feel that our yellow plan should reflect these considerations. I propose that all 46 students attend Adams School in person on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Wednesday will continue to be a remote learning day in order for the custodial staff to complete deep cleaning.

- Teachers will follow their remote learning plans on Wednesdays
- Special education concerns: Students will access Speech, OT, and SDI from home on Wednesdays.
- Assignments will be posted in Google Classroom.
- Rachel and Laura will work with students assigned to them when they are in the building. When students are not in the building, ed techs may be asked to do some or all of the following:
 - Provide services remotely under the direction of a teacher
 - Assist with lunch deliveries
- Elaine: Continue with usual duties, if possible work remotely on Wednesdays.
- Jan: Maintain schedule. Student lunches will need to be provided for students at home on Wednesdays.
- Albert and Joe: Allow time for deep cleaning on Wednesdays
- Joyce: Maintain usual schedule. Prepare for mid-day food delivery on Wednesdays.
- Amy and Jenny: Maintain usual schedule, if possible work remotely on Wednesdays.
- Matt Theriault: Maintain usual schedule, if possible work remotely on Wednesdays.

Kindergarten:

8:30 Arrival All Students, Dismissal of all students (Pre-K and K)

No students on Wednesday (in accordance with SU 93 Yellow Plan)

No specials missed, special accommodations for speech, RtI, and specially designed instruction.

Continue with outdoor education model for student health and safety.
