

**UPCOMING Meeting: 4/8 at 4:30 at Adams (also will be available via ZOOM link to be shared)**

**Minutes from PTC meeting 3/11/26 at 4:30 - all over Zoom**

**Present via Zoom: Tara, Fred, Lindsey, Amy**

Agenda:

- 1) Plan Items for Staff Breakfast on 3/26:
  - Made list of food and supplies for the French Cafe themed staff breakfast...that will last through lunch
  - Lindsey will take those items and put them into the sign-up genius and send out to the group for editing, etc. by the weekend
  - Email will go out by Monday 3/16 with info and the sign-up genius link (Lindsey will email out after edited by the group)
- 2) Fred will have the PTC email address and link on the website up and running soon
- 3) Tie-Dye Tees for Field Day:
  - Will set a date at the April meeting for the tie-dying of tees at Adams (tie-dying will occur in May, well ahead of the June Field Day)
  - Fred and Lindsey will discuss this at staff meeting to get days/times, etc. to bring back to PTC
  - Discussion items: windows for volunteers, donating tees and dyes (specifically chosen items) vs. donating money for PTC to purchase
  - supplies: tees, dyes, rubber bands, bags, etc.
  - Logistics - do outside, tees stay in bags tied up then hang on hangers to dry, shirts stay at school - LABELED with names, given to teachers to hand out on Field Day
- 4) Field Day: Ms. Monique is going to be overseeing this; how can PTC help? Volunteers? Supplies?  
\*\*Can Monique join the PTC meeting in April to discuss this?
- 5) Volunteering/Fundraising - money raising for PTC, 8th grade, Adams School things, etc....will talk about more at next meeting, but these ideas were discussed today - stepping toward a more communal approach, idea of PTC helping organize and funds going to chosen school/class projects/events, other support, 8th grade, potential donation outside of school, etc. Broadening to involve all age groups and more families.
  - PTC fundraising and Venmo - Fred will check on this
  - things discussed in this area:
    - food/drink fundraiser at the annual town meeting - this could be a good opportunity for 8th grade to "run," but others to help - especially 7th grade
    - could have similar sales at other upcoming events, such as the summer maker fair
    - other ideas to raise funds to support: classroom projects, coaches gifts, breakfast/snacks in office
- 6) Upcoming Agenda items:
  - Prior to April meeting, Tara will survey the school area for the teacher break room – and may send some follow-up questionnaire for that
  - Set May PTC meeting earlier in the month, as May gets busy (note: already School Board meeting on 3/6)
  - More on fundraising/volunteering - want to continue this discussion. Some things are already happening that look like we could have some great opportunities to work together. Would like to think forward to next year: concessions, etc. - do some brainstorming
  - Thinking toward summer and next school year, in general, for PTC

- Ask Ms. Monique if she can join the PTC meeting for a few minutes in April to share how PTC can help - or what she is envisioning at this stage, even though early?
